



# Nuckolls County Board Minutes



## APRIL 3, 2016 PROCEEDINGS OF THE NUCKOLLS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Nuckolls County Board of Commissioners met Monday, April 3, 2017 in the Board Meeting Room at the Courthouse, Nelson, Nebraska, per recess of March 20, 2017. Christensen, and Blackstone present for the meeting. The agenda of said meeting was remitted to board members in advance of the meeting and is posted in the County Clerk's office and on the County Website. Chairman Zikmund announced the 'Open Meetings Act Law' as posted in the Commissioners Board Meeting Room and handouts are available.

**The board reconvened at 8:30 a.m. A motion was made by Christensen to excuse Zikmund due to illness, approve the Agenda and the March 20, 2017 minutes. Seconded by Blackstone. Blackstone and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.**

Gary Warren, Highway Superintendent, Cindy Buescher, Executive Secretary and Jeff Wagner of Mainelli Wagner & Associates, met with the Board to give the weekly update on the road department. Their discussion included; all maintainer projects on Road 4000 North of Highway 8 done, trucks are hauling rock, blades are running working on potholes and washboards and Warren is working on a Plan of Action for several bridges.

**A motion was made by Christensen to accept the Monthly Board reports of the County Clerk, County Court, Sheriff and Clerk of the District Court as submitted. Seconded by Blackstone. Blackstone and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.**

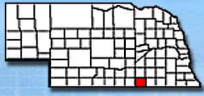
Sheriff Baker approached the board about holding an Active Shooter training course in the courtroom May 17, 2017. He explained that in partnership with Nirma it would be for not only courthouse staff, but local school staff as well. There would be a session in the morning and one in the afternoon to allow everyone to attend.

Jacie Milius, Jean Stichka and Dwayne Buescher met with the board to explain staffing ideas for this next budget year. With the upcoming loss of Crystal Fangmeier and the hiring freeze at the University of Lincoln the likeliness of getting a replacement for the Nuckolls County Extension Office looks slim. They proposed possibly budgeting for part time help. Christensen felt it would just be another bill the county would be picking up for the state. Blackstone while agreeing with Christensen, felt it would be an injustice to our county office to leave it short staffed. Both board members agreed they include it in their budget and they would revisit the issue during budget negotiations.

There were no sealed bids submitted for Culvert Project #708 that was Bridge Match Program Project.

Dan Swartzkopf, Krull Agency met with the board and insurance committee to discuss the quarterly claims reports.

The bids for courthouse lawn and abandoned cemetery were reviewed. Dave's Lawn Care submitted per mowing; Smith- \$50.00, Oxbow-\$50.00. Union- \$90.00 and Liberty- \$65.00. No bid for the courthouse lawn. Chris McClure submitted per mowing; Mt. Zion-\$110.00, Union-\$90.00, Oxbow-\$60.00, Smith-\$60.00 and Bostwick- \$150.00. The courthouse lawn care \$200.00 per mowing. **A motion was made by Christensen to accept bids from Chris McClure for the courthouse lawn care and abandoned cemeteries, for the 2017 mowing season. Seconded by Blackstone. Blackstone and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.**



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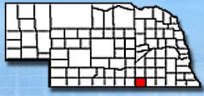
