



# Nuckolls County Board Minutes



## AUGUST 7, 2017 PROCEEDINGS OF THE NUCKOLLS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Nuckolls County Board of Commissioners met Monday, August 7, 2017 in the Board Meeting Room at the Courthouse, Nelson, Nebraska, per recess of July 24, 2017. Christensen, Zikmund and Blackstone present for the meeting. The agenda of said meeting was remitted to board members in advance of the meeting and is posted in the County Clerk's office and on the County Website. Chairman Zikmund announced the 'Open Meetings Act Law' as posted in the Commissioners Board Meeting Room and handouts are available.

**The board reconvened at 8:30 a.m. A motion was made by Blackstone approve the Agenda and the July 24, 2017 minutes with corrections. Seconded by Zikmund. Blackstone, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.**

Gary Warren, Highway Superintendent, and Cindy Buescher, Executive Secretary, met with the Board to give the weekly update on the road department. Their discussion included; Project #693 completed on Road 4400, Project #703 complete on Road 4400 & Road B, hauling lots of gravel due to July & August rains, damage estimates received on truck # 80 and trailer and drive way work.

At 9:00 a.m. was bid letting for Nuckolls County 2017 Culverts C65 (705) and C65 (706). Midwest Service & Sales of Schuyler NE submitted total bid of \$61,260.69 with delivery date of 7 to 8 weeks. Ace Irrigation of Kearney NE submitted total bid of \$51,184.35 with delivery date of 6-20 weeks. Warren called Ace Irrigation and was told 8 week delivery. Metal Culverts, Inc. of Jefferson City MO submitted total bid of \$65,404.85 with delivery date of 6-8 weeks. **A motion was made by Blackstone to accept the bid from Ace Irrigation of Kearney NE with total bid of \$51,184.35 with the delivery date of 8 weeks. Seconded by Christensen. Blackstone, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.**

**A motion was made by Christensen for the board to sign the Annual Certification Form for July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017. Seconded by Zikmund. Blackstone, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.**

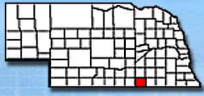

**A motion was made by Christensen for the Chairman to sign the District Court Child Support Agreement with Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services. Seconded by Blackstone. Blackstone, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.**

Nick Elledge presented the Emergency Management and Noxious Weed Budgets.

Jean Stichka and Jacie Milius presented Extension Office Budget. Stichka and Milius discussed with the board the desire to hire a part time person in the Extension office.

Gary Warren and Cindy Buescher presented County Road & Highway Bridge Buyback Budgets. Warren and Buescher went through the budget and answered questions about various line items. Christensen questioned the variances in line item amounts over the last 3 years. Warren explained that some line item amounts vary depending on the projected road projects for that year. Warren also cautioned that weather is also a large contributing factor on expenses, and keeping up bridge project replacements and maintenance should be

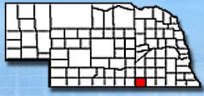

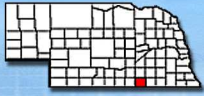
