SEPTEMBER 5, 2017 PROCEEDINGS OF THE NUCKOLLS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Nuckolls County Board of Commissioners met Tuesday, September 5, 2017 in the Board Meeting Room at the Courthouse, Nelson, Nebraska, per recess of August 28, 2017. Christensen, Zikmund and Blackstone present for the meeting. The agenda of said meeting was remitted to board members in advance of the meeting and is posted in the County Clerk's office and on the County Website. Chairman Zikmund announced the 'Open Meetings Act Law' as posted in the Commissioners Board Meeting Room and handouts are available.

The board reconvened at 8:30 a.m. A motion was made by Blackstone approve the Agenda and the August 28, 2017 minutes. Seconded by Christensen. Blackstone, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.

Gary Warren, Highway Superintendent, and Cindy Buescher, Executive Secretary, met with the Board to give the weekly update on the road department. Their discussion included; working on Project # 708, the tubes are in and they are working on the walls, Blade operators are out clearing sunflowers from in front of signs and filling holes Warren also informed the board that the frame on the 2005 Peterbilt checked out ok and Nirma is following up with the County's claim.

A motion was made by Blackstone to approve the Chairman to sign the contract between Nuckolls County and Ace/Eaton Metals for the Nuckolls County 2017 Culverts, C-65(705) and C-65(706). Seconded by Zikmund. Blackstone, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Blackstone for the Chairman to sign 2 Request to Place Buried Communications Facilities on Public Right-of-Way Within Corporate Limits of Nuckolls County for Road 4700 between Highway 136 and Road M. Seconded by Christensen. Blackstone, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Blackstone to Accept the County Court, Clerk of the District Court and County Clerk Monthly Board Reports as submitted. Seconded by Christensen. Blackstone, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.

Emergency Manager/ Noxious Weed Superintendent Nick Elledge gave the board a weekly update of activities and meetings schedule.

Terry Madsen, Phil Wehrman and Ron Herbek presented the board with safety, health and quality of life concerns regarding the Prairie Windfarm projects.

Kirk Hopkins with Business Telecommunications Systems submitted a bid to the board for a new telephone system for the courthouse.

At 11:00 a.m. the board started the Public Hearing for questions/concerns about the Nuckolls County 2017/2018 Budget. The Budget Committee and the board allowed 30 minutes of open time while no public concerns were brought forward from taxpayers, the board left the Public Hearing open until 1:00 p.m.

Eric Kennedy with Glenwood Communications submitted a bid for adding a hosted telephone system to the courthouse. Blackstone had some questions about some of the estimated figures. Kennedy said that he would submit a clearer detailed bid in the near future.

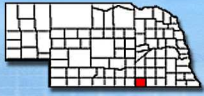
A motion was made by Christensen to Adopt the Nuckolls County 2017/2018 Budget. Seconded by Zikmund. Blackstone, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.

Warren, Buescher, Bolte, Ensign and Rogers were all present when the board held a discussion about the previously changed Vacation Accrual Cap. After discussing different options the board agreed that a 4 level accrual rate according to years of service was most appropriate. **A motion was made by Blackstone to amend the vacation accrual cap according to years of service; years 1-5 at 120 hours, years 6-10 at 140 hours, years 11-16 at 160 hours and 16 plus years of service at 180 hours. Individuals working a 37.5 hour work week accrual would be prorated accordingly. This would be effective as of January 1, 2018. Seconded by Zikmund. Blackstone and Zikmund voted Aye. Christensen voted Nay. Motion carried.**

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 2:05 p.m. until Monday, September 11, 2017.
