## SEPTEMBER 18, 2017 PROCEEDINGS OF THE NUCKOLLS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Nuckolls County Board of Commissioners met Tuesday, September 18, 2017 in the Board Meeting Room at the Courthouse, Nelson, Nebraska, per recess of September 11, 2017. Christensen, Zikmund and Blackstone present for the meeting. The agenda of said meeting was remitted to board members in advance of the meeting and is posted in the County Clerk's office and on the County Website. Chairman Zikmund announced the 'Open Meetings Act Law' as posted in the Commissioners Board Meeting Room and handouts are available.

**The board reconvened at 8:30 a.m. A motion was made by Christensen approve the Agenda and the September 11, 2017 minutes. Seconded by Zikmund. Blackstone, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.**

Gary Warren, Highway Superintendent, and Cindy Buescher, Executive Secretary met with the Board to give the weekly update on the road department. Their discussion included; Project #708 on Road 2700-2800 complete, tree clean up on Road W between 3900-4000, tree clean up on Rad 3500 between Road AA and Z, 2 driveways complete, motorgrader cleaned up weeds on Road 4200 between Road V and Road U, #1 John Deere Dozer had 2 sensors fixed, #18 John Deere Motorgrader going in for seal repairs and a discussion was held about employees using the shop after hours.

Elledge gave his weekly update including; sending letters out to land owners, Emergency Management Social Media up and going per request of the Emergency Management Association, and pick up should be in within the next couple weeks.

Assessor Susan Rogers explained that she would be ordering a tablet device that would assist the Assessor Office with their field work documentation.

John Hodge with the Nelson Community Club requested the board's permission to display the LED holiday lights again. Board agreed.

The board reviewed Preventive Maintenance Agreements sent by Rasmussen Mechanical Services. The board requested that the Maintenance Agreements be put on the next agenda and an individual with Rasmussen Mechanical be present to answer questions.

Blackstone requested that courthouse telephone system bids be put on the next agenda.
