NOVEMBER 13, 2017 PROCEEDINGS OF THE NUCKOLLS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Nuckolls County Board of Commissioners met Monday, November 13, 2017 in the Board Meeting Room at the Courthouse, Nelson, Nebraska, per recess of November 6, 2017. Christensen, Zikmund and Blackstone present for the meeting. The agenda of said meeting was remitted to board members in advance of the meeting and is posted in the County Clerk's office and on the County Website. Chairman Zikmund announced the 'Open Meetings Act Law' as posted in the Commissioners Board Meeting Room and handouts are available.

The board reconvened at 8:30 a.m. A motion was made by Christensen approve the Agenda and the November 6, 2017 minutes. Seconded by Blackstone. Blackstone, Zikmund and Christensen all voted aye, 0 voted nay. Motion carried.

Dustin Gay with Energizer Electric explained to the board that the electrical panel project that he completed over the weekend went smooth. Gay explained that various parts of the previous existing panel crumbled and the main disengage did not shut down when pulled. Gay stated he felt this was a safety hazard resolved and replacing the electrical panel was a smart investment.

A discussion was held about some of the entrances into the offices. The board requested Clerk Miller to contact local contractors to assess and place bids for these repairs.

Nick Elledge gave the board a brief update on the schedule of the Noxious Weed and Emergency Management departments. Elledge explained that he had been at conference the previous week earning 10 of the 20 yearly credit hours needed for the Noxious Weed position.

Susan Rogers, Darrell and Diane Kile, Gary Warren, Cindy Buescher, and Rob Thompson of Aurora Coop joined the board to discuss the dust issue at intersections 3750, 3800 and 3900 along Nebraska State Highway 8, caused by traffic going in and out of Aurora Coop. Warren presented the research options discussed in the previous meeting for road treatments. The board asked Warren to get estimates of what expenditures would be to start these treatments and an estimate of paving the Aurora Coop and Sedan facility roads. The board asked that the matter be continued on the next agenda.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 10:20 a.m. until Monday, November 20, 2017.
